

In order for West Houston Shooters Club (WHSC) to hold enjoyable and safe matches, all Participants and Spectators agree to the following:

- 1.0** I understand that it is a privilege, and not a right, to participate in WHSC matches and events. And I understand Club Officers, Safety Officers (SOs), and Match Staff are Volunteers, giving their time freely. Therefore, I agree that unsportsmanlike conduct or unjustified complaints, of any kind, will not be permitted by anyone, at any time, for any reason.
- 2.0** I will not communicate with others in a threatening, harassing, or abusive manner for any reason; and will make every effort to refrain from the use of vulgar or foul language.
- 3.0** If I have a question or an issue, my first contact is with the Chief Safety Officer (CSO), then Match Director (MD), then the Club President.
- 4.0** I will follow all the Safety Rules of WHSC and the host range(s). The safety of Shooters, Match Officials, and Bystanders shall always be my primary objective.
- 5.0** Prior to and during a match or event, I will refrain from the use of alcohol, substances, or medications that may negatively impact my ability to shoot safely.
- 6.0** I will listen carefully, and refrain from talking during Shooters' Briefings and Stage Briefings.
- 7.0** I understand it is my responsibility to be ready to shoot when called to the line.
- 8.0** As a Participant, I understand it is my duty to help paste targets & reset stages between shooters unless I am the current shooter, the on-deck shooter, or have just finished shooting - unless instructed otherwise by an SO.
- 9.0** I understand that everyone attending Matches or Events is expected to assist with set-up, tear down, and cleaning up at the range or other venue when the Match or Event is finished.
- 10.0** I understand that I am a guest of the host range, and it is my responsibility to know and abide by the host range rules.
- 11.0** I understand that violations of these provisions may result in my Disqualification from a match, or elimination from an event, and repeated or egregious violations may result in the revocation of my current membership, and I may be barred from any or all future participation in WHSC activities.

West Houston Shooters Club enjoys rights and privileges at Peacemakers Gun Range that are truly unique. Our continued relationship depends on our ability to be good tenants & good neighbors. The following rules must be obeyed by everyone entering the range property for our events:

Property Access: If the Front Gate is open, you are welcome to enter. The gate will be closed during the event.

Driveway: The Main Gate to The Chains is available to everyone. Visitor street vehicles are not allowed into the Bays or on the Bay Access Lane. Access beyond The Chain is limited to Authorized Personnel only.

Parking: Visitor Parking is “head-in” to the fence on the east side of the driveway from the Main Gate to The Chain. Legitimate Handicap Plates or visible Hang Tag may use the restricted spaces – the ADA Designee must be in attendance.

Firearms & Ammunition: COLD RANGE! Other than placing a PCC in a transport cart at your vehicle, firearms may not be uncased, cased, or otherwise handled outside the boundary of a Safe Area. Uncased PCC is carried muzzle up – readily visible Chamber Flag is Mandatory. No ammunition handling in Safe Areas. Your vehicle is not a Safe Area. Firearms may only be loaded/unloaded under the direction of a Safety Officer or Range Officer. Visitors arriving with, or competing with, their Carry Gun must immediately contact a Safety Officer to unload. No individual practice or warm-up is allowed.

Trash: The Range provides trash receptacles located near the back entrance of the main building, but please respect our “Pack It In – Pack-It-Out” policy. If you see trash on the ground, please pick it up and place it in the appropriate container or pack it out.

Brass: If you are not a member of West Houston Shooters Club, do not pick up range brass.

Reporting: If you observe any violations, mis-use of property or equipment, or other improper behavior or activity, please notify the Match Director, Range Manager, or any WHSC Board Member.
